ANNUAL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Our Annual Meeting was held Sunday, October 20th, with ten members in attendance.

Officers and committee members for 2025 were voted into office as proposed by the nominating committee.

The 2025 budget was accepted as proposed.

We will continue to use supply ministers and speakers to lead our Sunday Worship Services.

We will continue to use the aluminum ramp donated by the Youngs, rather than build a new ramp. THANK YOU, Stan and Claudia!

A new cooktop will be purchased for the kitchen in The Red House.

The two small rooms off the large dining room will be painted.

Friendship Room windows will be repaired, and the room will be painted. Article 11 was amended to also include making the door going into the sanctuary ADA compliant.

The old asphalt on the church driveway will be removed and replaced with gravel; subject to approval by Andy's Summer Playhouse, because they own about half of the driveway.

Mae Williams will be hired to complete an application for adding the church to the National Register of Historic Places.
